- a. 8th grade Theme Dance in March (Jenny Albright is lead)- Benevity Grant from Kelly earmarked to help pay for dance, check received in August for \$534.60
- b. Is a Field Day planned and will PTO be asked to support- Yes, details to follow
- c. Senior Appreciation Events- looking for a senior parent to work with CCA Admin and Senior Class in planning and support of events. Ideas are: Awards Night catered dinner, Signing Day.
- d. Student Parking Lot- no plans
- e. What is the senior class size? 26 students
- f. Next year approximately 640 students, waitlist for all grades; there are 530 students this year. Next year class sizes:

- g. PTO purchase of Awning for drop off/pick up sidewalk area- The cost will exceed PTO funds available. CCA is asking for funds for administration area decorations and signage
 - h. School Access Security- CCA actively monitors security for entire school, school pays for a Security Officer out of budget for school. As school expands will continue to develop security plans.
 - i. PTO Support requested for upcoming School Board Fundraiser with “Vertical Raise”, this will be an e-mail fundraiser with a goal of raising \$35-\$100K to allow school begin Phase 2 construction- site work/drawing for gym and additional instructional space. Fundraiser will be in Feb/Mar.
 - j. Brandy Grindle earmarked the most recent Pfizer Benevity Donation/Grant for the Science Department. Her guidance is for money to be used for purchase of chemistry/science equipment, like a centrifuge or something else, that will have an extended usage period over the next few years. The grant is \$1,574.25. The Science Department balance is \$1,591.44. Cynthia Quiggle is the CCA Science Department Supervisor and lead for this action.
